

In Memorium: Roy R. "Robin" Lewis III



The world lost one of its biggest wetland advocates, Roy R. "Robin" Lewis III on September 24th. For more than four decades, Robin set a standard of quality and commitment that earned the respect of clients, regulators and colleagues alike. He was among the first in the U.S. to successfully restore damaged wetlands, and was a leader in the vanguard of progress in habitat restoration and creation. Robin designed more than 125 completed wetland restoration or creation projects in the

United States, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. He earned a welldeserved reputation among his peers as a leader in ecosystem management and restoration around the world. ASWM worked with Robin for over 25 years. He was one of the chapter authors of "Wetland Creation and Restoration: Status of the Science" in 1990 edited by previous ASWM Executive Director, Dr. Jon Kusler and Dr. Mary Kentula. This seminal publication set the standard for understanding the science of wetlands restoration and creation for many years. Just this past spring, Robin was awarded the Wetland Business Leader Award by the Environmental Law Institute's prestigious National Wetlands Awards program. All of us at ASWM will greatly miss Robin and his infectious passion for wetlands. Rest in peace, Robin.


