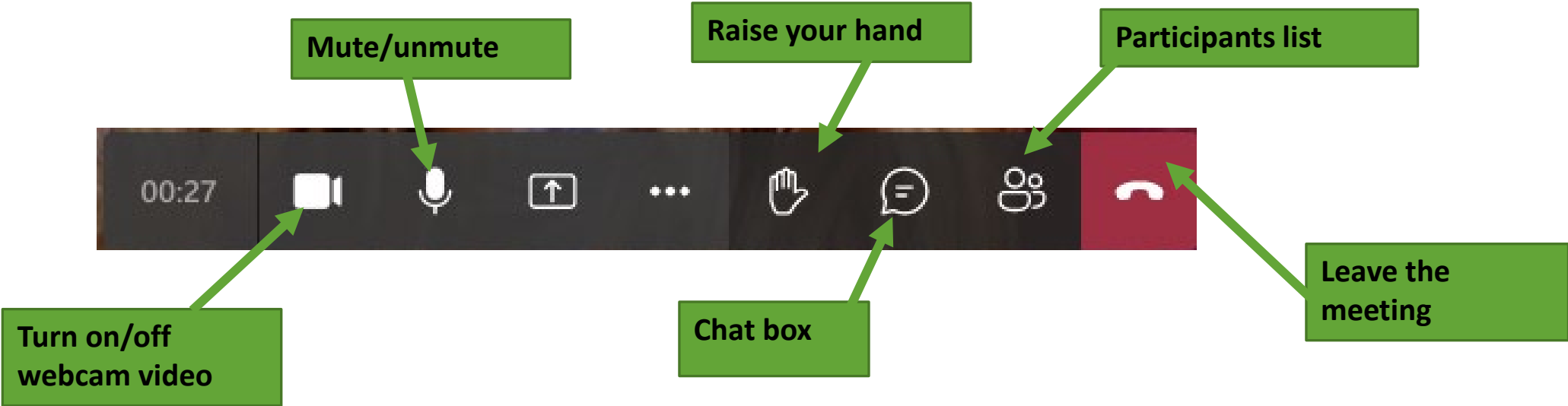

Participating in a meeting




Audio and Video: You can mute yourself and turn your video off.

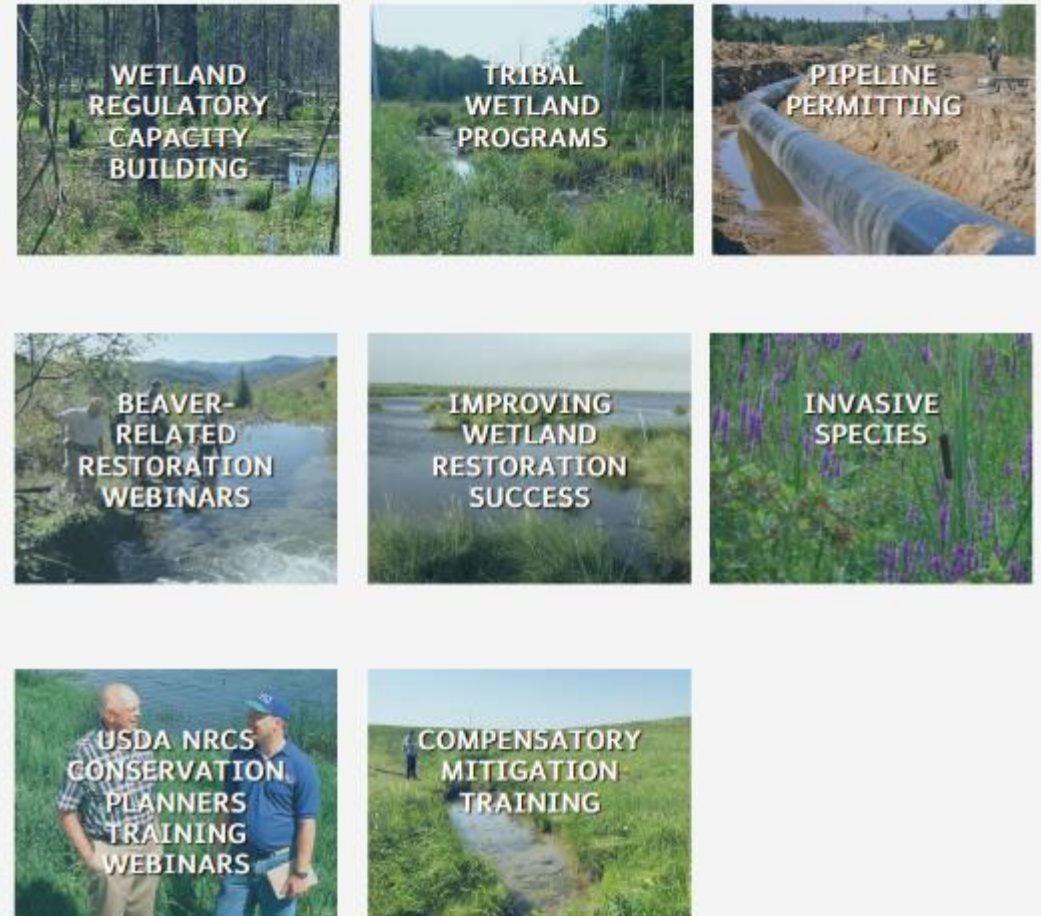

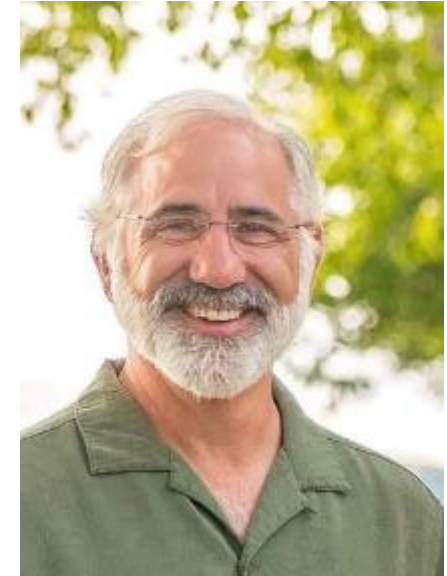
