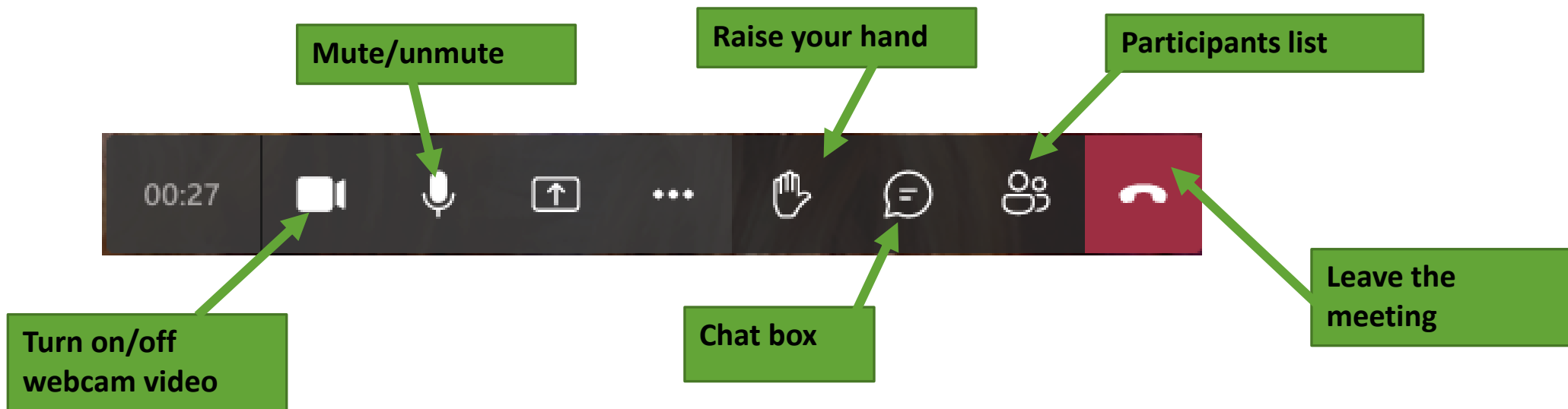


**Participant list:** Allows you to see everyone who is attending the meeting.

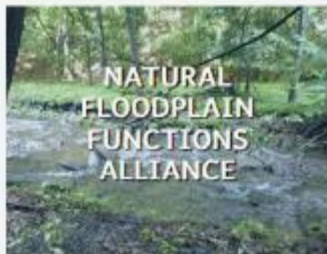
