



#### ASWM Submits Comments on NRCS Wetland Conservation Compliance Interim Rule

On February 5th, 2019, the Association of State Wetland Managers submitted comments to the Federal Register on the Wetland Conservation Compliance Interim Rule proposed by the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). Among other recommendations, ASWM urges NRCS to discontinue the certification of pre-1996 wetland determinations and resume the use of up-to-date, technically rigorous methods for wetland determinations. 
