



WETLANDS ONE-STOP MAPPING

The Association of State Wetland Managers in collaboration with Virginia Tech's Conservation Management Institute (CMI) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's Northeast Region created Wetlands One-Stop Mapping to provide easy online access to geospatial data on wetlands and soils produced by federal and state agencies. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS), through its National Wetland Inventory

roduced wetland geospatial data for most of the country. While different agencies post data on their own sites, there is not a single place to go for these data. Wetlands One-Stop Mapping provides



The website also provides links to other federal and state websites that contain information on wetlands and geospatial wetland data. Among the national datasets accessible via Wetlands One-Stop Mapping are the NWI's wetlands mapper, USDA's web soil survey, USGS's national hydrography data and hydrologic units (HUCs). Links are also provided to NatureServe Explorer and the U.S. National Vegetation Classification Hierarchy Explorer along with guidance on how to extract descriptions of welland plant communities from those sites for specific areas of interest.
